

### Survey Methodology


- Northwest Local School District

- Confidence Interval: + / 5.36%
- Confidence Level: 95%
- 40% /60% Male Female Respondents



In-Field (6/11/09 - 6/13/09)



























Question 5: Do you believe the taxes you pay to support the Northwest Local School District are:




Question 6: Do you believe that the education provided to the students of the Northwest Local School District is:


Question 7: The school district has made significant budget cuts and eliminated many programs during the past two years. If a levy passed, what would be the top eliminated item you would bring back to the schools?












Question 12: How would you rate the job performance of the new Northwest Local School District Superintendent Bill Stetler during his first nine months on the job?












Question 17: What is the number one reason that you believe the residents voted against the last NLSD levy?

Question 20: How would you like to receive more information about the NLSD?






