Dear Parents,

Welcome to first grade. This will be an exciting and important year for you and your child. Working together as a team- child, parent, and teacher, we will strive to make it a successful year.



Whenever possible this summer, visit the library and read with your child. These experiences initiate interest in reading, provide children with good models of reading and help children begin the development of beginning reading skills.

To ensure a successful beginning have your child maintain such kindergarten skills as: being able to print his/her first and last names, being able to identify the basic colors and being able to identify and write capital and lowercase letters. At the beginning of the year our math program requires students to be able to count from 0 to 100, use tally marks and locate numbers on a number grid. We think reading is so important that we read to your child each day and we hope you, as parents will read to them each day also.
