You may make your credit card payments by either visiting tax.ohio.gov or by calling 1-800-2PAY-TAX (1-800-272-9829). The Ohio jurisdiction code is 6446. Official Payments charges a convenience fee equal to 2.5% (or \$1, whichever is greater). This fee is paid directly to Official Payments Corporation and is based on the amount of your tax payment. Do not file Ohio voucher form SD 100ES if you use the credit card method of payment.
- Check or Money Order If you do not want to use an electronic check or credit card to make your payment, you may send in a personal check or money order made payable to the School District Income Tax with your quarterly estimated Ohio form SD 100ES.
