



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Building and Renovations

Northwest Local became eligible for approximately \$30 million in 2008 for the building and renovation of the middle school, W.S. Stinson Elementary, and the high school. The money will be received from the Ohio School Facilities Commission (OSFC), a department of the State of Ohio that received funding from a tobacco settlement. In other words, the facilities project is not covered through the local general fund.

Like most construction projects the money from the OSFC will be released to us on a quarterly basis as the construction project

progresses. A budget was established cooperatively by a team of representatives from Northwest Local, the OSFC, and our architectural firm, L/D Design Group.

The budget agreed upon calls for the middle school to be renovated and have an addition of approximately 12 thousand square feet added at a cost of \$14 million.

A budget amount of \$12 million was allotted for renovation and construction designed for the intermediate building and W.S. Stinson.

The final portion of the OSFC money will be used to add a gymnasium and two classrooms to the high school at a cost of \$4 million.

All of these projects should be completed by the start of the 2012-2013 school year, and our final construction payment from the OSFC is scheduled for the third quarter of 2012.

What to expect on return to school

With the facilities project underway in the district, we have decided to borrow a catch phrase from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, "TEMPORARY INCONVENIENCE - PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT."

Students returning to the middle school and Stinson will find concrete floors with no coverings, open ceilings, temporary hallways and new traffic patterns at the middle school and high school. Dust will be at a minimum since demolition work will be completed before students enter the buildings. The cafeterias and kitchens will be clean and organized. In addition, we can assure you that all of the buildings will be

safe. All life safety systems are in place, and the buildings have been inspected by fire officials.

One aspect that won't change is the continued presence of a caring, dedicated faculty and staff; and students will receive quality academic instruction.
